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Esteemed dignitaries present on the dais, managing committee members, print and electronic media persons, parents, staff, students and other learned members. I'm greatly thrilled to read out the report of Centurion Public School in this wonderful evening.

The Centurion Public School is an attempt to improve on the existing education system which was conceived out of a new concept of teaching and learning based on playful learning without allowing pressure and stress upon the children. The school is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi, bears affiliation no. – 1530139 and is running classes from L.K.G to XII. The total strength of students is 1163 and present faculty strength is 64. Our motto is "Connecting with Knowledge". The school offers – Best teachers, experienced leadership, fun filled classes, modern audiovisual teaching aids (Teach Next), computer Labs, well-stocked library, transport facility, huge and spacious campus. The school runs remedial classes to eliminate the practice of tuitions. So far we have sent two batches of students for CBSE class-X annual examination.

**Ms. Sappa Sneha** of class X, CBSE (2012-13) obtained CGPA: 10/10 and she received the appreciation certificate from the Regional Office, Bhubaneswar for obtaining A1 grade in all the subjects.

This year we are preparing 51 students of class X to appear the CBSE annual exam at JNV, PKD and also 24 students of XII which is the first batch to appear exam at the same centre. Apart from academics, we always encourage the students and give moral support to participate in different activities and competitions for their all round development. Our students had participated, received prizes, trophies in district as well as in state level competitions.

- 1) **Ms. Shivani Patanaik** of std-V has participated in the district level folk dance and got selected to state level for Governor's Trophy.
- 2) In the district level English Debate Competition for Senior Secondary students, two of our students **Ms. Abha Meenakshi** and **Mr. Aashirvad Satapathy** of std- XI received 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes respectively. They also secured the same positions in the district level competition held on the occasion of National Voters Day.
- 3) **Ms. Shivani Pattanaik** of Std-V awarded with 1<sup>st</sup> prize in the district level Odiya debate competition.
- 4) In the district level song competition for seniors our students **Ms. Subhasree Satabdi Palo** of std-IX and **Ms. Preeti Padma Patro** of std-IX secured third position.
- 5) Similarly, **Ms. Anyesha Mandal** of std-VI and **Mr. Ayush Burman Mandal** of std-II won 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> position in the district song competition for junior group.
- 6) On the occasion National Press Day, a district level competition was held. Our students **Mr. Aashirbad Satapathy** of std-XI got selected in 1<sup>st</sup> position and **Ms. Subhasree Satabdi Palo** of std-IX won 2<sup>nd</sup> position.
- 7) **Ms. Deepika Behera** of std-VIII and **Ms. Anyesha Mandal** of std-VI have been qualified as child artist for All India Radio, Jeypore.
- 8) Also **Ms. Anyesha Mandal** of std-VI stood first in the Inter School Art competition organized by Axis Bank.
- 9) Our students **Mr. Suman Sahu** of std-VIII and **Mr. G-Sridhar & Mr. Mikeswara Jena** of std-XII had participated in the CBSE Regional level Science Competition held at N.H.Goel World School, Raipur (Chhattisgarh) during Dt. 2<sup>nd</sup> -4<sup>th</sup>, Sept. 2013. Mr. Sahu received special appreciation certificate from CBSE.
- 10) Our teachers are being regularly trained and deputed to attend workshops, seminars and conferences in various institutes outside the school. In a sequence, the language teachers **Ms. Sunita Panigrahee** and **Mr. J.K. Nayak** has attended workshop on effective teaching of English at Gandhi Public School, Gunupur.
- 11) The Principal(+2), **Dr. G. Krishna Rao** has attended International Conference of Principals at New Delhi, which was organized by Teacher Sity, NUEPA & NCERT. Thought provoking and brain storming sessions were conducted for future development schools affiliated to CBSE.
- 12) Apart from above, the school conducts orientation classes for teachers every year – during summer for about 15 days. Besides this the various in-service teacher training programmes were conducted with ultimate objective of all round development of students, particularly keeping in need of teachers in the changing scenario. These include Action Research in Education, Student Behaviour Modification Techniques, The Teacher as a Professional, Effective teaching of NCERT text books etc.

The infra structure of the school includes 40 classroom to accommodate 30-40 students in each class room equipped with modern gadgets. We have a well equipped library with reference books, periodicals, magazines, news papers which not only cater to the diverse needs of the students and teachers but also makes them in updating their existing knowledge. Three science laboratories are well furnished with all scientific instruments as per CBSE norm and facilities are being provided to enable our students for practical classes. Keeping in trend with the needs of the students ultra-modern computer lab has been setup with 25 computers having internet facilities. In addition to these, a Math's Lab and language room have been setup to meet the learning needs of the students. Financial support is also being provided to deserving meritorious students for continuation of their study in CPS.

In order to maintain harmony in each sphere of academic and activities, the school has its Disciplinary Committee, Academic Council, Examination Committee, Cultural Committee, subject wise committee, library committee and scout/guide team. To foster a healthy and congenial relationship amongst parents, teachers and students regularly parent teacher meeting is being conducted on second Saturday of every month. We expect each one's participation for better understanding of the child's performance and academic standards. To keep abreast of various professional standards career counseling has been provided particularly in higher classes. We are strongly working to introduce coaching classes for IX and X onwards from the next academic session so that our students can excel in the competitive world.

Our school is the instrument for the realization of national ideals also. To foster the feelings of oneness and Nationalism, we observe National Days like Independence Day, Republic Day, Teachers Day, Children's Day, Annual Day etc.

Discovering the latent potentialities of every student and transforming it into a reality is one of the priorities of CPS. To achieve this, the school has been organizing many Academic, Curricular and Co- Curricular activities like Singing, Dancing, Tae-Kwondo, Drawing, Exhibitions. We have also introduced Bharat Scouts and Guide for enhancing disciplinary attitude in the minds of the students. Similarly, ABACUS mathematics classes are being conducted in both the campus of CPS. Science exhibition and seminars are also being organized.

I feel proud and delighted to announce here that, the school is shortly going to admit students in class XI for commerce subjects from the academic session 2014-15 and opening of std- XI in Arts is in pipeline. In order to create awareness for vocation and develop employability skills among students, the Centurion Public School has implemented Vocational stream in classes IX onwards from the current academic session. Physical Education has been added as an additional subject in std- XI and XII.

We are grateful to the President of CUTM Prof. (Dr) Mukti Kanta Mishra, and Vice-President of CUTM Prof. D. N. Rao for their continuous support, motivation, guidance and commitment in shaping the present form of this institution and constant endeavour for achieving more success in future.
